VISUAL & DIAGNOSTIC INSPECTION

Check dashboard for DPF warning lights		
Inspect for excessive exhaust smoke		
Scan for DPF-related fault codes (e.g., P2463, P2002)		
Check backpressure sensor readings		
Record current mileage since last DPF cleaning		

MAINTENANCE & CLEANING ACTIONS

TASK:	COMPLETE (✓)	NOTES:
Remove DPF for manual/off-truck cleaning		
Inspect filter for damage, cracks & compromise		
Employ DPF Cleaning steps per manufacturer's instructions or use a DPF Cleaning service		
Re-inspect DPF & all sensors for damage post-cleaning		
Reinstall, replace gaskets & clamps, and check all connections
